Longrock to Treliever

As part of our planned programme of works, overnight road closures will be in place from Monday 7 September on the A394 to allow us to carry out routine maintenance activities. Work will include minor repairs, gully emptying, sign cleaning and verge and hedge cutting.

Works will be carried out at night between 7.00pm and 6.00am, prioritising times when traffic levels are low. As we work along the A394, we will carry out our activities in phases to keep road closures within the locality as short as possible, minimising disruption.

While the road closures are in place, all through traffic will need to follow the diversions at all times. Bus services will be given access through the closed sites, driving slowly to maintain a safe working environment for our teams.

Why are we doing this work?

We need to ensure Cornwall's highways network is maintained to a safe and serviceable standard. Our routine maintenance includes minor works and cyclic activities such as gully cleaning and sign repairs.

Diversion

Signs will be placed at major junctions prior to the road closure on the key routes to take non-through traffic away and keep traffic disruption to a minimum.

We understand that diversion routes can be lengthy at times. We must use roads of the same designated level or higher, ensuring that all road users can travel along the marked diversion. These measures are necessary for safety reasons.
