

RAIL IMPROVEMENT WORK

All weekends in February

- Track replacement and platform refurbishment works at Dawlish
- Buses will replace trains between Exeter St Davids and Plymouth. Non-stop buses will also run between Tiverton Parkway and Plymouth
- Trains will continue to run between Plymouth and Penzance as well as between Newton Abbot and Paignton (except next weekend Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 February)
- Trains from London Paddington and Bristol will terminate at Taunton or Exeter St Davids

Saturday 19 to Sunday 27 February

- Bridge repair work will be taking place between CREDITON and Yeoford
- Buses will replace trains between CREDITON and Barnstaple/Okehampton
- Trains will continue to run between Exeter and CREDITON

Saturday 5 to Sunday 13 March

- Track renewals will be taking place in the Truro area as well as platform extension works on the St Ives branch

Saturday 5th and Sunday

- 6 March – Replacement buses run between St Austell and Penzance (including the Falmouth and St Ives branch lines)
- Monday 7th March to Sunday 13 March – Replacement buses run between Truro and Penzance (including the St Ives branch)
- A reduced train service will run where the mainline remains open

Monday 24 April to Monday 9 May

- Track renewals and structures work will be taking place along the Dartmoor Line to Okehampton to support the start of hourly services in the summer
- Buses will replace trains between CREDITON and Okehampton
- Trains will continue to run between Exeter and CREDITON
